Dear Trainee,

The class for which you are applying begins on Tuesday, _____. We ask that you arrive at least 10 minutes early for class to give your dog time to settle down, relax and relieve themselves outside. The club meets each week at the Villa Park Masonic Lodge, 26 W. Central (one block west of Ardmore and immediately north of the Prairie Path). Parking is available behind the building.

We ask that you carefully read the attached sheet governing conduct on the training grounds. Enclosed are a Schedule of Classes, the time each class meets, and the tuition fee for each class. The checkmark indicates the class for which you are applying. Also enclosed is an application form along with a health and waiver form. You are to fill out and sign the application and waiver form. Your veterinarian must fill out and sign the health form. Return all forms along with a check for the appropriate tuition made payable to WILDWOOD DOG TRAINING CLUB to:

Training Equipment

Required equipment is discussed in the first class session. Proper training equipment consists of the following items:

- A properly fitted training collar of either metal or nylon. If the collar is made of metal, the links should be sturdy and not bracelet or coarse links. The collar must fit properly so that there is no more than the width of your closed fist when pulled taut around the dog's neck.
- Six-foot flat leather lead. Nylon leads are not recommended. No retractable leads or chain lead allowed.

To avoid buying the wrong equipment, we urge you not to buy any equipment prior to the first class session. Wildwood Dog Training Club maintains a supply of leashes and collars in a range of sizes and weights to suit most dogs. All our equipment is of the highest quality and competitively priced.

Training Course

The 12-week basic beginner's course consists of 11 nights of instruction in the proper methods for teaching your dog to respond to basic obedience commands: sit, stand, down, stay, heel, come. The 12th night is a graduation designed to test you and your dog's mastery of these skills. For those interested, Wildwood Dog Training Club also offers advanced training courses to prepare the dog and handler for AKC competition or just to perfect the skills learned in class.

The instructors and members of Wildwood Dog Training Club welcome you and your dog to our club. Please feel free to ask questions. We are eager to help you develop a well-behaved, better-loved pet.

SCHEDULE OF COURSES, CLASS TIMES AND TUITION FEES

Wildwood Dog Training Club runs four Puppy classes per year and four Beginner classes per year. A new Beginner class starts up at twelve-week intervals. We accept 18 dogs per class. Enrollment into these classes is based on **FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED basis: that is, as we receive your application and tuition fee, we reserve a place for you and your dog in the class. The health form can be sent later or turned in the first night of class.** If we receive your application and fee after a class is filled, you will be verbally notified and we will either return your check or you may have your application applied to the next available class.

You should receive an acknowledgement within a week informing you of your accepted enrollment into the class for which you have applied.

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONDUCT

- (1) Please be on time for your class. We hope you will enjoy the training that is to follow.
- (2) Handlers must be at least 16 years of age. Also it is strongly recommended that the same person train the dog each week for the entire class for consistency reasons.
- (3) No tuition fees will be refunded on or after the first night of class. Should special circumstances occur, please contact the club's registrar.
- (4) Children are welcome but we insist they **DO NOT PET ANY DOG OTHER THAN THEIR OWN!** Children are not allowed on the training floor while class is in session. Children must be kept under control and should have some supervision other than the parent that is training.
- (5) Dogs must be on a short leash and under the handler's control at all times. Sniffing other dogs, barking, lunging, and other uncontrolled behavior will not be tolerated.
- (6) Sensible shoes and clothing must be worn. We recommend tennis shoes as the best and most comfortable footwear.
- (7) Please do not feed your dog less than four hours prior to class. This will hopefully prevent accidents at school.
- (8) Dogs must be exercised before being brought to school. The area just north of the building is designated as an exercise area. Clean up supplies are provided for accidents in class and you are solely responsible for cleaning up thoroughly.
- (9) No bitches in season allowed. The heat period lasts approximately 21 days. Before the bitch is brought back to class, we suggest bathing and brushing her to remove all traces of scent. There are no make-up classes. You should come to school and observe the class in order to continue training at home. No homework sheets will be mailed for classes missed. If a graduation is missed, notify the class Registrar so arrangements can be made to go through graduation at another time.
- (10) Your training collar is for training only. A buckle collar should be used when not training. **NO TAGS** will be allowed on the training collars. They are annoying and distracting to your dog, your instructor, and your classmates.
- (11) No smoking inside the training facility.
- (12) No intoxicating beverages or drugs consumed prior to class. Please remember...Dog training takes two hands and a clear head.
